P&C Responsibilities

Currimundi's P&C Association is a group of volunteers that give our time freely in support of the school community.

We have an Executive group that is elected annually who are responsible for running the P&C and collaborate closely with the School Principal & Leadership Team. We also have 'Members' which include parents, teaching staff and community members.

While our P&C also employs some paid staff for roles in the Tuckshop and Uniform Shop, the core strength of the P&C is our wonderful volunteers. From supporting the tuckshop to organising and running events, we couldn't do it without our volunteers.

Wave Break Tuckshop

Our 'Wave Break Tuckshop' is open five days a week during school term. We sell a wide variety of healthy lunch items and snacks to keep our Curra Kids satisfied, along with celebratory whole-class treats like ice blocks for birthdays or special occasions.

Tuckshop orders are delivered to your child's classroom at break time. If you want to make sure you don't forget, you can also place your orders up to one month in advance!

Small snacks, drinks, ice blocks and juice-base slushies can be purchased from the tuckshop with cash or you can set your child up with snack money on our ordering system 'Munch Monitor' (check out our ordering guide to learn more).

Frozen and cold snacks are held at the Tuckshop and collected after lunch with the student's labelled bag.

Uniform Shop

Our Uniform Shop is open 24hrs a day online through Munch Monitor with orders being delivered to your child's classroom on Monday and Wednesday afternoons. Our shop, located within the Tuckshop, is also physically open from 8-8:30am Tuesday morning and 2-3pm Thursday afternoon. During these sessions you can try on sizes for new uniforms and browse our second hand items too.

As your child grows, uniforms that are too small can be donated to the Uniform Shop and help new families at Currimundi State School.

We run bake sales and BBQs throughout the year and for special events like elections.

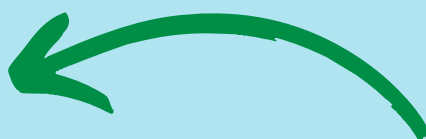

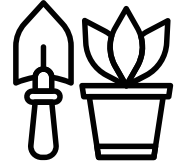
✓ DONATE PRODUCTS & SERVICES
