English: Exploring procedural text and Exploring characters and plot

Written procedure

To plan and create a multimodal procedure.

Create a new story using a familiar character

To create a written and/or multimodal story, based on a familiar character.

Maths: In Semester 1 students will consolidate and build on mathematical skills.

Locating features and using maps

Purpose: To locate and identify positions of features on a map. To move positions by following directions and pathways on a grid.

Using data to answer a question

Purpose: To use a range of methods to collect, record, represent and interpret categorical data in response to questions.

Science: Mix, make and use (*Chemical sciences*) and Toy factory (*Physical sciences*)

Combining materials for a purpose

Students investigate the combination of materials used to make an object for a particular purpose. Students record and represent observations and communicate ideas.

Designing a toy

Students design a toy that will move with a push or pull, and describe a change to the toy and how it affects the toy's movement. Students pose an investigation question and make a prediction about the toy's movement. Students represent and communicate observations and ideas.

HASS: Impacts of technology over time

Students interpret, compare and sequence objects from the past and present and investigate the impact of changing technologies on people's lives over time.

The Arts

Drama: Stories come to Life

Students make and respond to drama by using picture books as a stimulus as they bring them to life with voice, movement, soundscapes and improvisations for performance.

Music: Music in our New World

Students explore fiction and non-fiction books and everyday texts as stimulus for music making and responding.

Health: A little Independence

Students describe physical and social changes that occur as they grow. They recognise their own and others' strengths and achievements.

Good healthy choices in my environment

Students examine health messages related to the health benefits of physical activity, nutritious dietary intake and maintaining good personal hygiene habits to help them stay healthy.
