English

Unit 2: Understanding and creating informative texts

Students read, view and comprehend a simple informative text, and explore how a similar topic is presented in an imaginative text.

They create a written and multimodal informative text.

Maths

Unit 2: Number, Algebra and Measurement

Students partition, rearrange, regroup and rename numbers to 999 to assist with calculations and use mathematical modelling to solve practical additive problems involving money.

They read time to the hour, half hour and quarter hour on an analog clock and use a calendar to determine the number of days between events.

Science

Unit 3: Earth and Space Sciences

Students identify and describe celestial objects and predictable patterns in the sky.

HASS

Unit 2: Impacts of technology over time

Students interpret, compare and sequence objects from the past and present and investigate the impact of changing technologies on people's lives over time.

MUSIC Unit 4: Music in our New World

Students explore fiction and non-fiction books and everyday texts as stimulus for music making and responding.

Health

Unit 2: Good healthy choices in my environment

Students examine health messages related to the health benefits of physical activity, nutritious dietary intake and maintaining good personal hygiene habits to help them stay healthy.
