English: Constructing a persuasive response (Argument) and Examining stories and adapting ideas

Persuasive texts (Persuasive letter)

Students write a persuasive letter.

Narratives: Using a text for inspiration

To discuss, comprehend and to create an imaginative text inspired by a favourite narrative.

Maths: In Semester 1 students will consolidate and build on mathematical skills.

Exploring numbers to 9 999

To represent and order numbers beyond 10 000.

Interpreting and creating maps

To interpret and create a map.

Conducting a guided statistical investigation

To conduct a statistical investigation and create, interpret and compare data displays.

Solving number problems and exploring simple patterns

To solve number problems and explore simple patterns

Measuring and comparing duration and events

To measure and compare duration and events

Science: Life and living (Biological sciences) and Spinning Earth (Earth and space sciences)

Investigating living things

Students group living things based on observable features and distinguish them from non-living things.

Investigating the sun, Earth and us

Students explain the cause of everyday observations on Earth, including night and day, sunrise and sunset, and shadows and use diagrams and other representations to communicate ideas.

HASS: Our Unique Communities

Students investigate the significance of Anzac Day commemorations for different groups, how and why people participate and contribute to the community and aspects that have changed and remained the same over time.

The Arts

Drama: Dramatic Traditions

Students make and respond to drama by exploring dramatic traditions and practices in stories of Australia (including Aboriginal drama and Torres Strait Islander drama) and Australia's neighbouring countries as stimulus.

Music: Musical Characters

Students make and respond to music by exploring the ways that characters from film, television and media are portrayed musically. This includes theme songs, sound effects and soundscapes that represent characters from television, film and media.

Health: Good friends and I am healthy and active

Students respond to a case study and a series of activities about changes and making new friends.

Students complete a supervised assessment. They examine strategies to achieve healthy and active strategies and read case studies to assist the characters in the case studies to apply these strategies to their activity routine.
