Unit 2: Number, Algebra, Measurement

Students use the properties of odd and even numbers, choose rounding and estimation strategies to determine reasonableness, use proficiency with addition and multiplication facts to add, subtract, multiply and divide and use mathematical modelling to solve practical financial problems. They convert between units of time when solving duration problems.
