English: Engaging with stories for enjoyment and Retelling stories + Initialit

Talking about stories

To retell an event and make connections to personal experiences within a preferred familiar story.

Creative Response

To respond to and retell a familiar story to peers.

Maths: In Semester 1 students will consolidate and build on mathematical skills.

Connecting and sequencing numbers and exploring repeating patterns

Describing position and location

Collecting, sorting and comparing data

To collect, sort and compare data.

Understanding numbers from 1 to 20

Students make connections between number names, numerals and quantities up to 10, count to and from 20 and order small collections.

Sorting shapes

Science: Weather watch (Earth and space sciences) and Our material world (Chemical sciences)

Examining the weather

Students suggest how the weather affects themselves and other living things. Students share observations about the weather.

Making a wind ornament

Students describe the observable properties of materials from which an object is made. Students ask and respond to questions and share and reflect on observations.

HASS: My family history

Students explore important events celebrated in their lives, and to identify how people and objects help them to remember.

The Arts

Visual Arts: Stormy Clouds

Students explore how visual language can be used to communicate and relate to mood and feelings.

Drama: My Place

In this unit, students make and respond to drama by exploring the school/local community/imagined places as stimulus for process drama and dramatic play

Music: Let's sing and play together

Students explore rhymes and songs as stimulus for music making and responding.

Health: I can do it and I am growing and changing

Identify different settings where they can be active and how to move and play safely

Identify and describe the different emotions people experience.
