English: Stories and Surprises and A Sea of Information

Speaking and listening

Students share ideas and express an opinion about a character from a familiar imaginative text.

Writing and creating informative texts

Students create an informative text to report on a familiar topic.

Reading, viewing and comprehending informative texts

Students read, view and comprehend a simple informative text.

Maths: Number, Space, Statistics, Algebra, Measurement

Collecting, representing and discussing data

Students collect, record and represent data in a one-to-one display and compare and discuss data.

Partitioning one- and two-digit numbers and solving addition and subtraction problems to 20

Students partition one- and two-digit numbers in different ways and solve addition and subtraction problems to 20 using calculation strategies.

Science: Deep Dive Adventure (*Biological sciences*)

Describing a habitat

Students describe changes in their local environment and how different places meet the needs of living things. Students respond to questions, make predictions and share their observations with others.

The Arts

Drama: Shopping fun

Students make and respond to drama by exploring the theme of shopping.

Dance: Shape dance

Students make and respond to dance by exploring two-dimensional shapes and three-dimensional objects as stimulus.
